From Mr. Steele-

All students are expected to be on the field, rehearsing properly for the entirety of every rehearsal throughout the year.

Learning drill/work/choreography in a competitive marching band takes continued trial, error and adjustment.

No performer has ever been perfect but those who rehearse properly throughout the season are the ones who come the closest.

Drill and work is meant to be done in coordination with the entire ensemble. It is impossible for directors to properly assess or teach drill, work, and choreography with students missing.

Each performer needs to be there to learn and refine every part of the show.

Students who miss rehearsals greatly reduce the effectiveness of the entire band, not just for the missed rehearsal, but for the entire season.

ABSENCES:

The tentative season schedule is listed on page 6. We will finalize this schedule as soon as all competitions have been confirmed. Please look this over very carefully and mark all dates on your home calendar(s). Page #2 of the forms packet is the Performance & Rehearsal Attendance Contract where you make a promise to have your student attend the entire season of rehearsals and performances. We take this very seriously. Before you schedule a doctor appointment or your student takes a part time job, ask yourself if it violates your promise to the band.

SITTING OUT:

Students may sit out for up to 5 minutes during a rehearsal. Beyond that, a student must return to rehearsal or they will need to contact a parent to come and take them home. If students are well enough to be at school, they are well enough to rehearse. If a parent cannot come and take them home, the student must sit in the stands or go to the office. A student who misses rehearsal time during a week including sitting out, may be held from that week's performance(s) unless director's explicit approval is given. A student who misses more than 10% of rehearsal time in two weeks may have his/her spot closed for a portion of the show. An alternate performance situation will be devised (when possible) for students with closed spots.

PARTICIPATION IN PERFORMANCES:

All students are required to attend each performance, except in the case of family emergency or illness. Injured or ill students are expected to be on the sideline at performances if they are unable to march, but not sick enough to have to stay home.

VACATIONS:

We are not asking you to give up all summer vacations. We are asking you to be mindful of when your student is absent. The majority of marching band families (and all LOMB staff) schedule their vacations so as not to conflict with rehearsal dates. It can be done. Your student's absence hurts the entire band and it's unfair to those families who remain faithful to the schedule.

LEAVING REHEARSAL/LATE ARRIVALS:

All student early departures or late arrivals must be prearranged, having discussed the reason with Mr. Steele. Mr. Steele may grant an excused absence or not. Work will never be an excused reason to miss rehearsal. Students who miss rehearsal for unexcused reasons may be held from that week's performance.

DOT/DRILL BOOKS:

All students are required to have a completed dot/drill book at all rehearsals. The student may be asked to rehearse even without a completed dot/drill book, but they will only receive half credit for rehearsals until it is filled out. The book must be shown to Mr. Steele in order to reinstate full credit. Continued lack of a completed dot/drill book could result in the directors filling the student's spot with another student or the spot may be closed.

CLOSED OR FILLED HOLES/SPOTS:

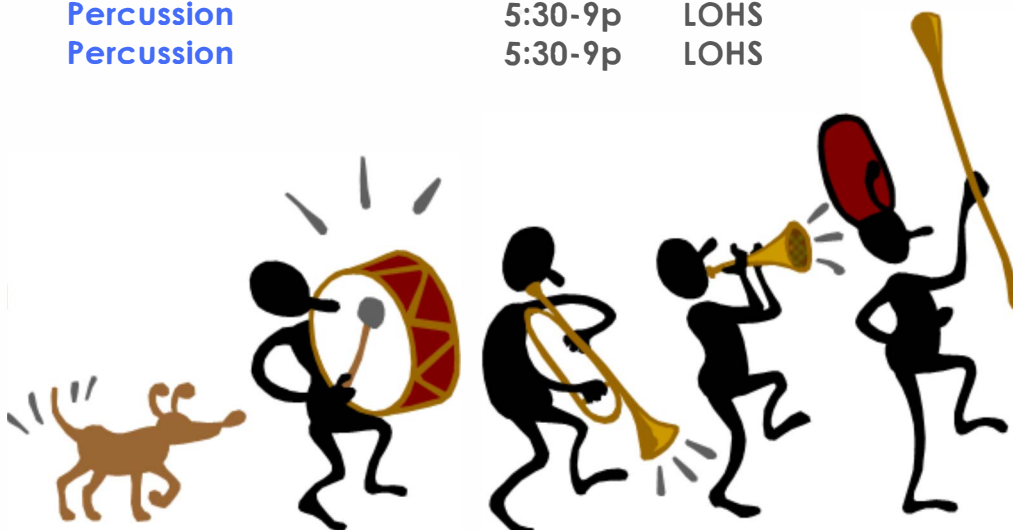
If a student's hole/spot is closed or filled by another student, that student will still be a performer in the show, possibly in their original role but not for the entire show, or there will be an alternate performance role created.

"BEFORE SUMMER" REHEARSAL SCHEDULE

It takes a lot of work and commitment and practice to become one of the top marching bands in the state. With that being said, practices **WILL** start before the end of this current school year. If for some reason your student is in a spring sport and cannot make these practices, please know there is no penalty to your child should they have other school commitments but it is **STRONGLY** recommended that they attend these rehearsals. However, once the summer rehearsal season kicks off please know that **ALL CAMPS** are **MANDATORY**.

LOMB tuition for the 2023-2024 season is \$1300.00

The LOBB makes every effort to minimize costs throughout the entire season.

The more successful fundraisers we host, the easier it is to keep marching costs as low as possible.

To that end, we expect all families to donate time, respond to calls for food or supply donations, and participate in all fundraising activities.

"It takes a village"

Deposit- \$200.00 per student, required and non-refundable. We use this fee to hire show writers for the 2023 season with music and drill written specifically for your student based on their skill level. This fee is applied toward your total marching band cost and is due no later than May 1st 2023. This payment plus the required forms secures your student's spot in the 2023-24 LOMB program.

Payment Schedule- All marching band payments not received by the LOBB or postmarked later than Nov 1st will result in non participation in winter programs, prohibited to participate in following years of marching band.

- No refunds will be given after July 1, 2023
- All accounts are expected to be up to date by August 1, 2023 prior to attending band camp
- All accounts are expected to be up to date by September 1, 2023. Students whose accounts are not up to date at this time will not participate in any competition until account is up to date.
- All accounts are expected to be up to date by October 1, 2023 prior to attending State Finals Competition.

Multiple Child Policy-

If you have more than one student in the competitive program, LOMB discounts \$200 for every student beyond the first child. All students must be enrolled in the marching band for this to apply.

Voucher Points-

You may earn up to \$600 in voucher points coming from concessions and/or charity poker events. Voucher points are deducted from the first child's account up to \$600. All vouchers earned after the last payment (Oct 1 through Nov 5) must be turned in before November 30, 2023 in order to be credited toward 2023 LOMB fees. No vouchers will be accepted after this date.

Scrip-

We have a knowledgeable team of volunteers ready to help you take advantage the Great Lakes Scrip program. Your immediate and extended family members can earn money to apply toward your marching fees by making your usual household purchases using Scrip cards. Fundraising-

The more participation from parents and families with fundraising, the more money can be saved for the following years fee.

Sponsorships- 25% of **GOLD** and/or **SILVER** sponsorship allocated to your students marching band fees.

The LOBB also puts out periodic calls for donations of food or supplies. Food savings are important in helping to keep cost down.

Students will learn and perfect marching skills during this intense week of instruction. They will memorize both music and drill with the help of an expanded staff of specialized instructors. Because of the secluded environment, directors and instructors can provide individual attention to every student and students bond as a cohesive unit. A very small staff of parents attend as chaperones.

All members of the 2023 LOHS Dragon Marching Band are required to attend band camp. Please plan family vacations and summer jobs accordingly. **Attendance is MANDATORY** but it's the most fun your student will have all summer.

All accounts are expected to be paid to up to date by August 1st prior to attending band camp.

Although NOT encouraged you may pick up your child from band camp with prior written arrangements with Mr. Steele.

A Band Camp Information Meeting will be held latter in the summer. The planning committee will outline procedures, changes, and will provide a packet of camp specific information.

Camp Chaperones-

We charge chaperones \$50 for the complete week of meals; this keeps season fees as low as possible.

If you are interested in chaperoning, please indicate this on page #2 of the forms packet along with your \$50 camp payment.

- Minimum of 6 chaperones ride bus to and from camp
- Keep students on schedule (wake-up, meal times, practices, lights-out)
- Monitor students to insure they eat and remain well hydrated
- Required to assist in day and evening activities, make evening patrols,
- Run errands and perform various tasks for both band and camp staff

NOTICE: Chaperones who interfere with rehearsals or training will be asked to leave camp immediately
